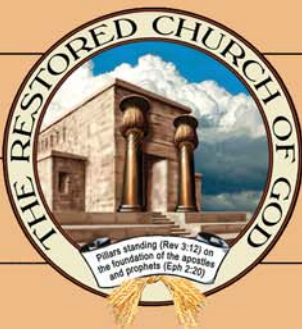

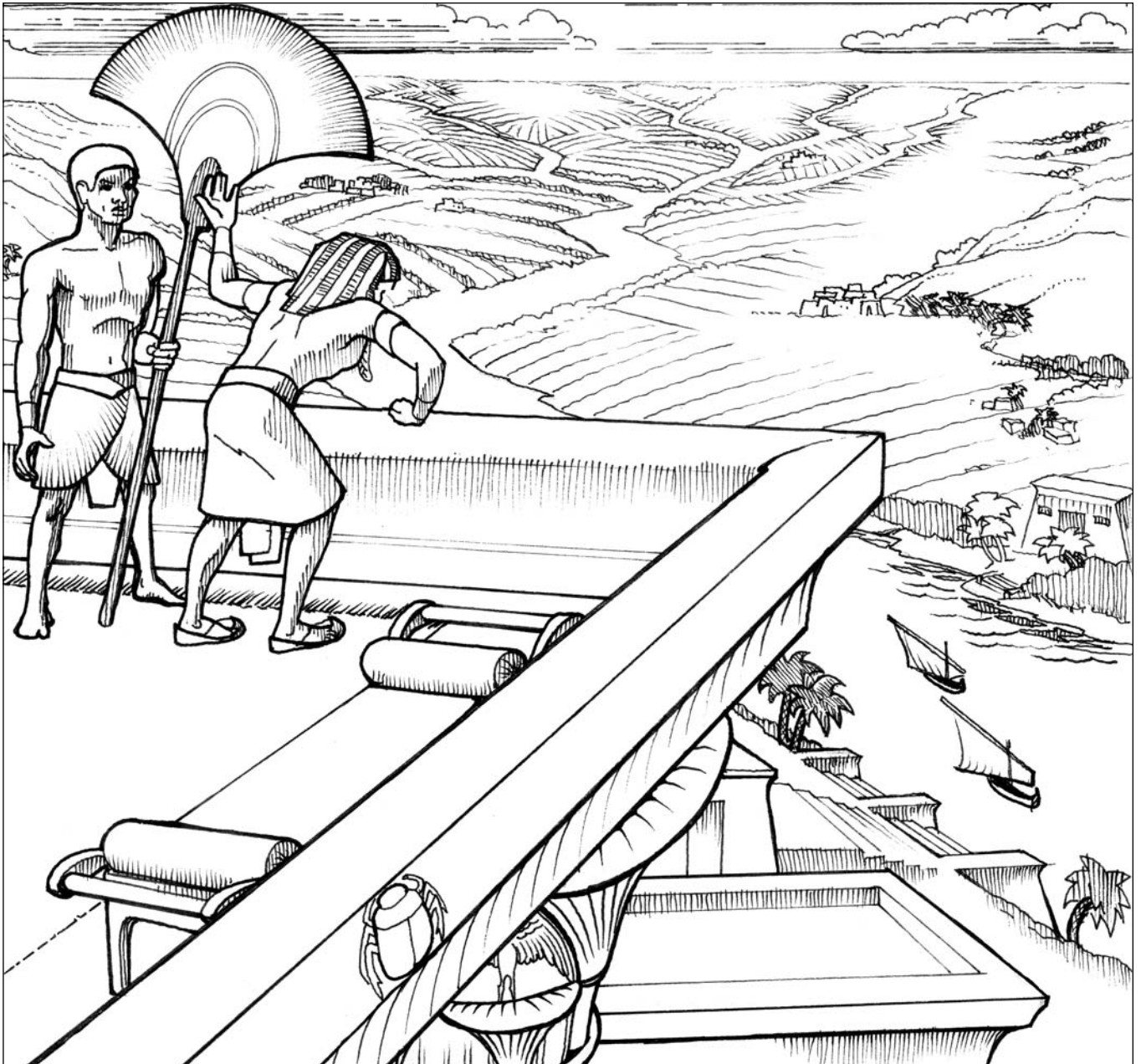
Moses is Born



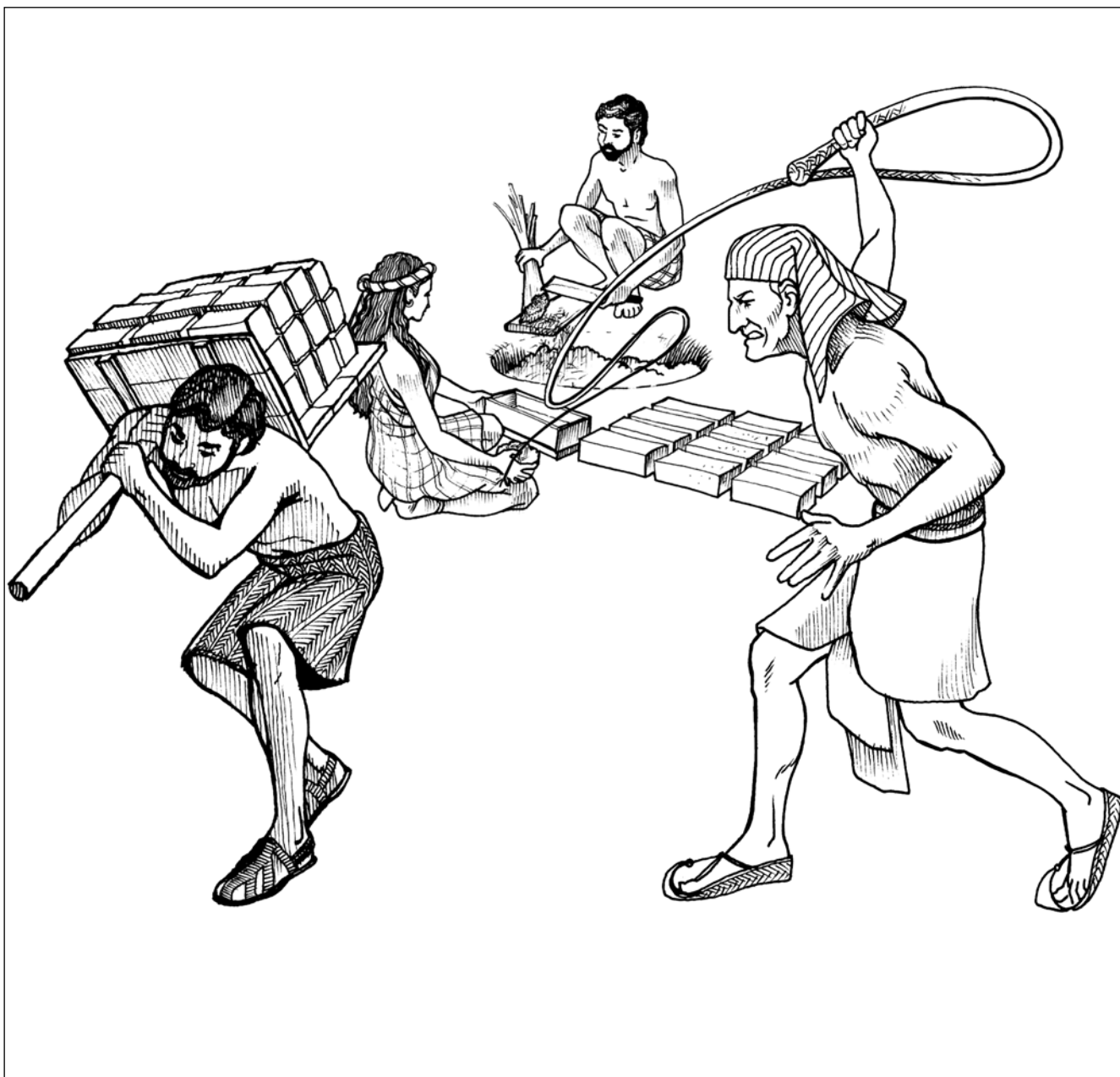

Moses is Born

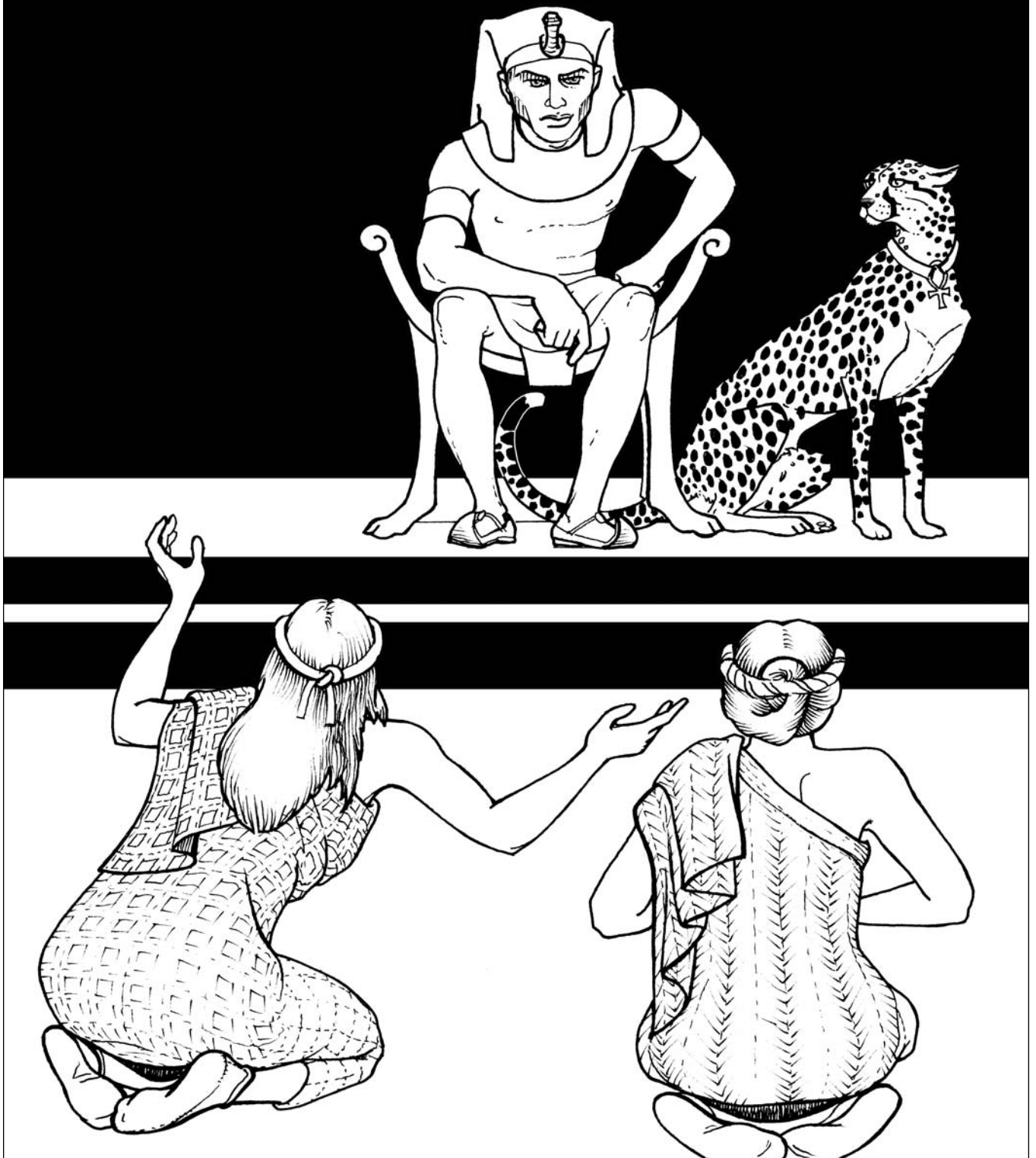
