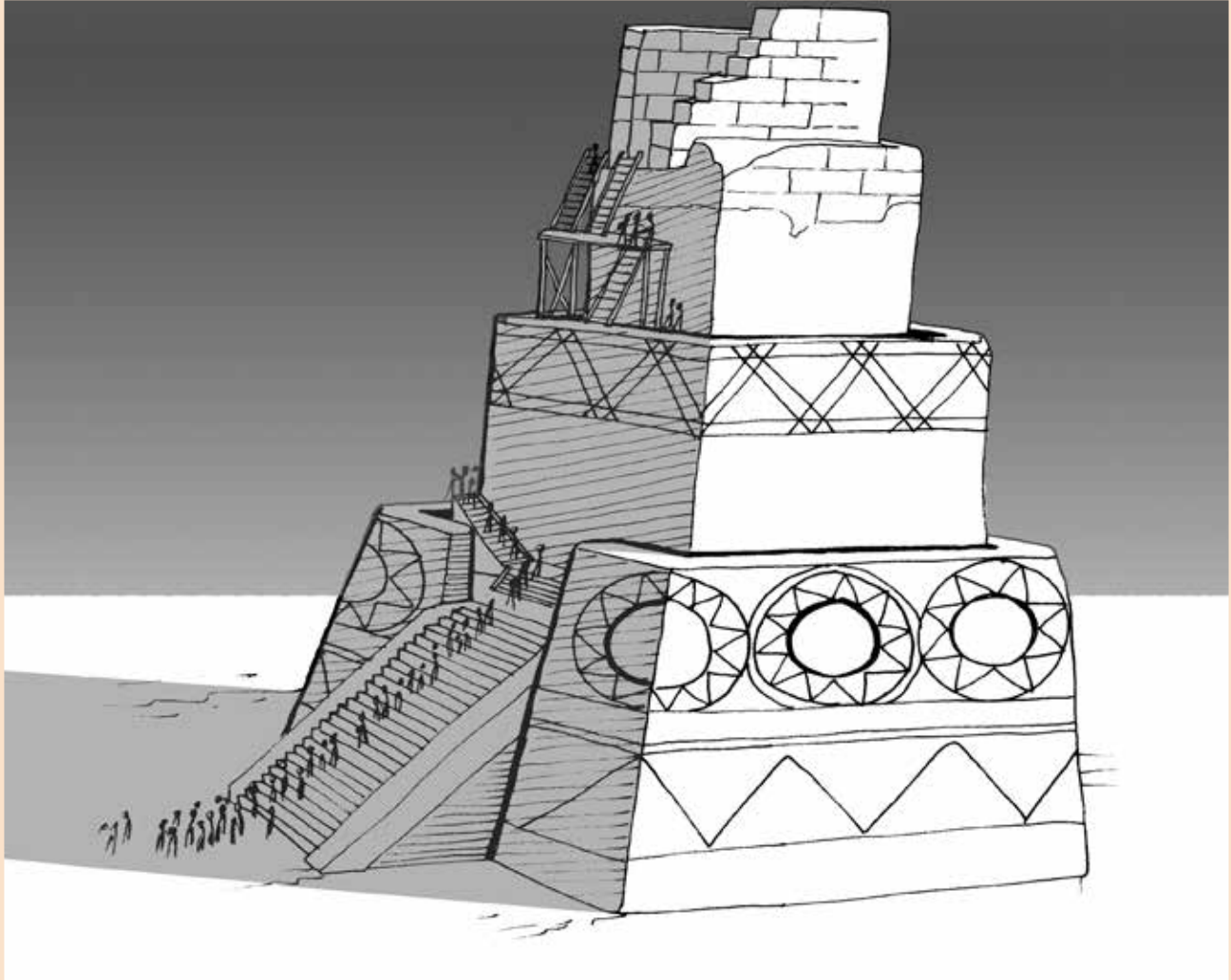
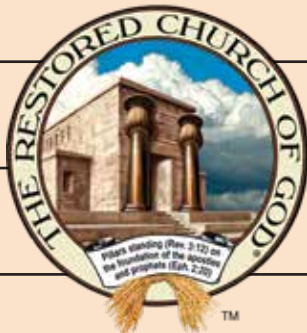

But Nimrod did not obey God. He focused on himself. He led people to worship false gods like the sun and snakes. The people followed Nimrod.

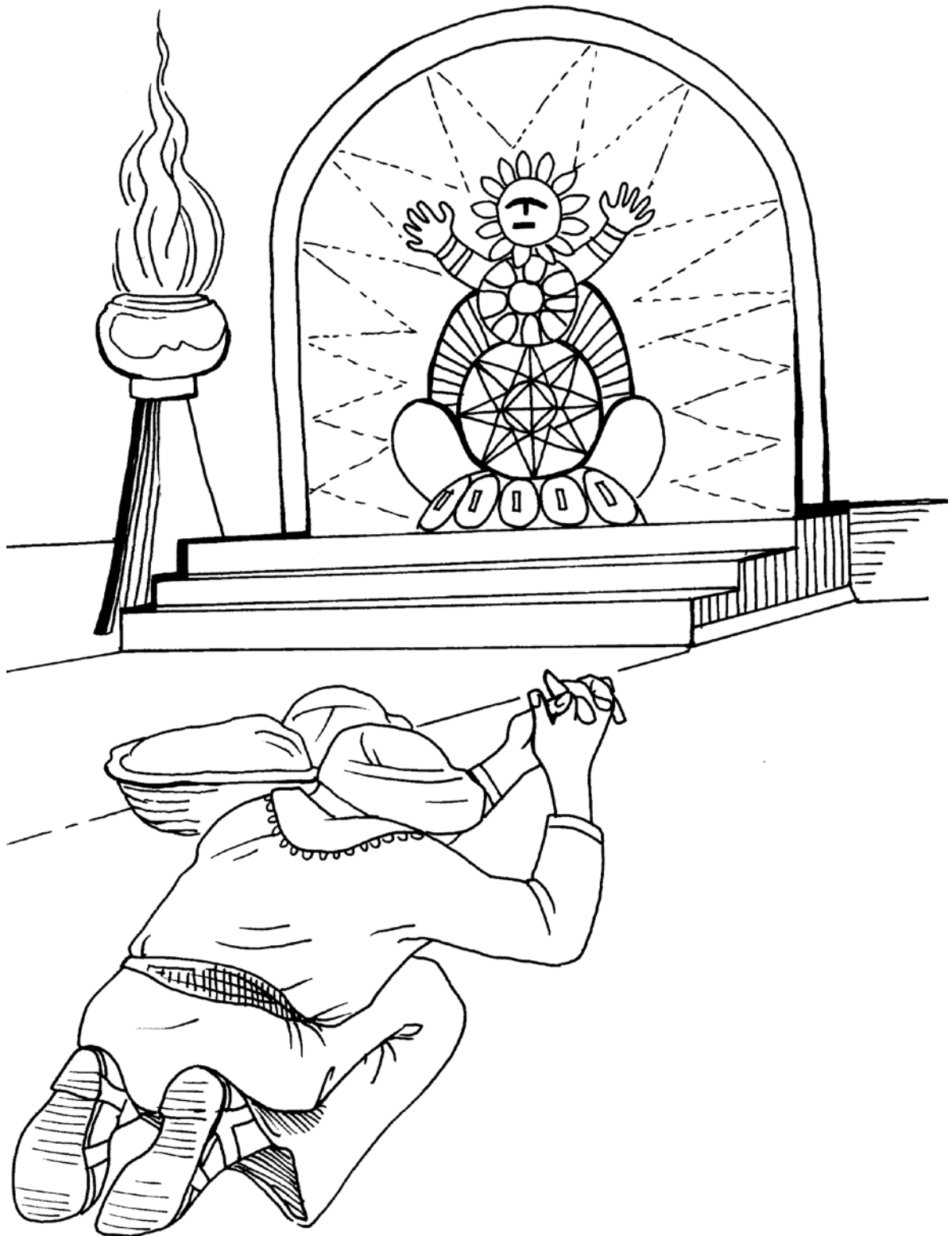
Nimrod made plans to build a large tower. The people helped him to build this tower.

God was not pleased with the people. They would not obey His Laws.

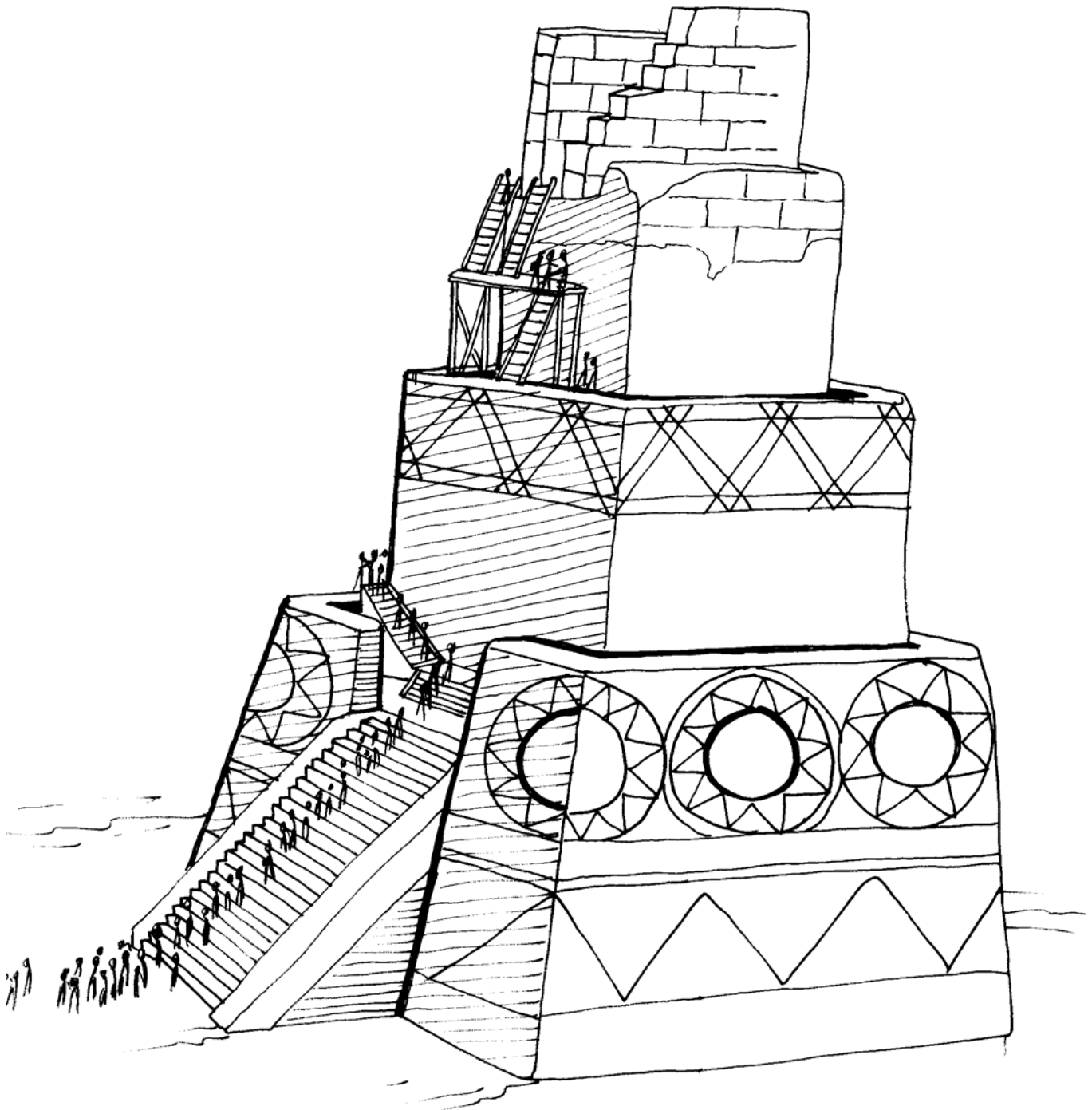
Nimrod was a mighty hunter.



Following Nimrod, the people worshipped false gods.

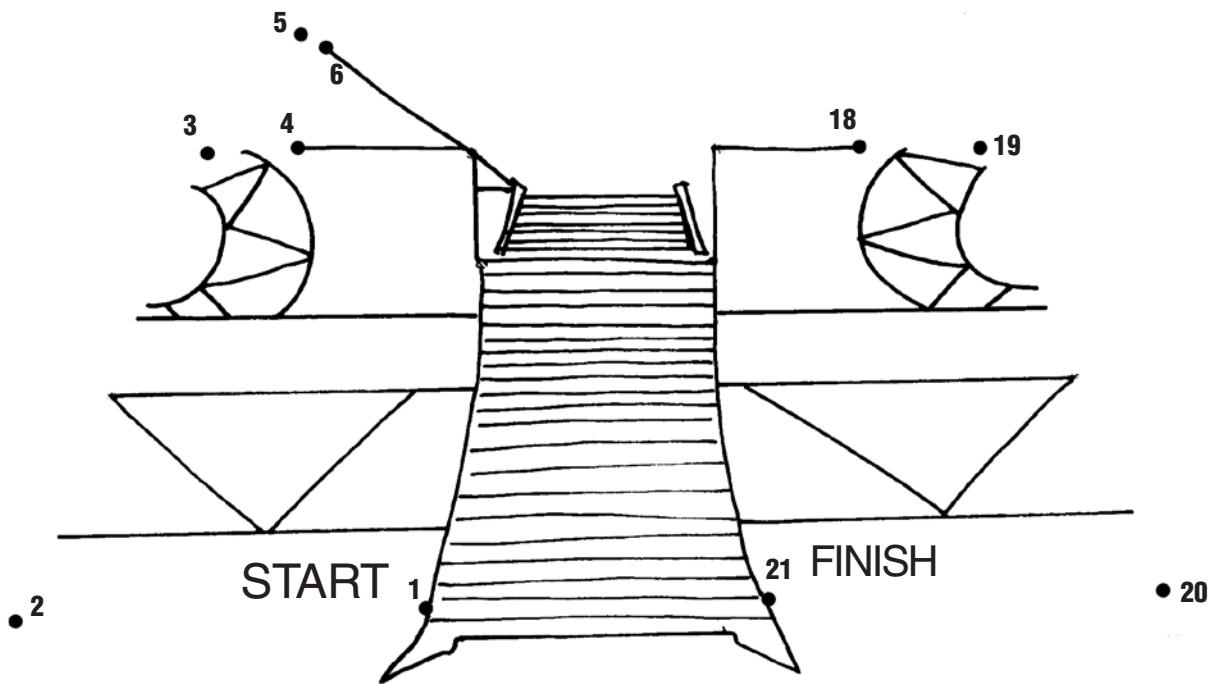
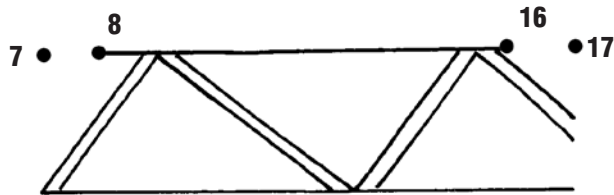
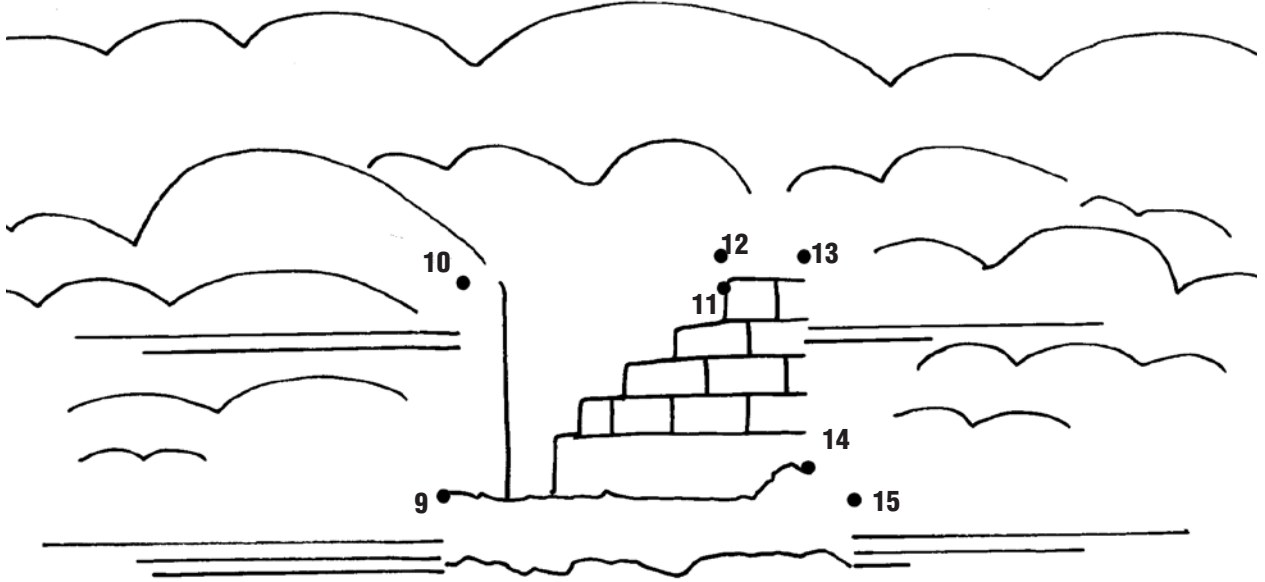


The Tower of Babel

God changed the people's language.



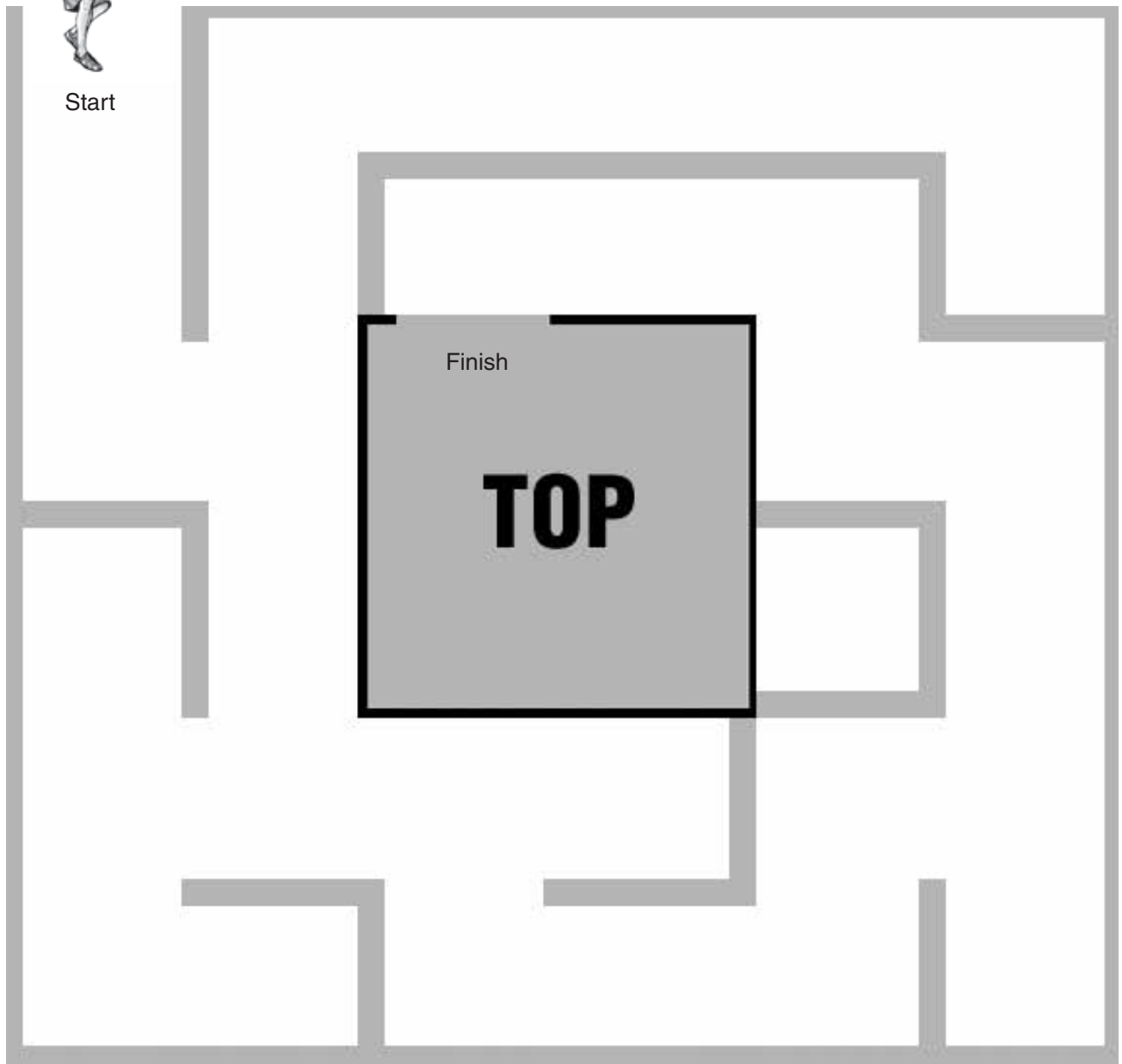

Show the man how to get to the top of the Tower of Babel, so he can place the brick there.



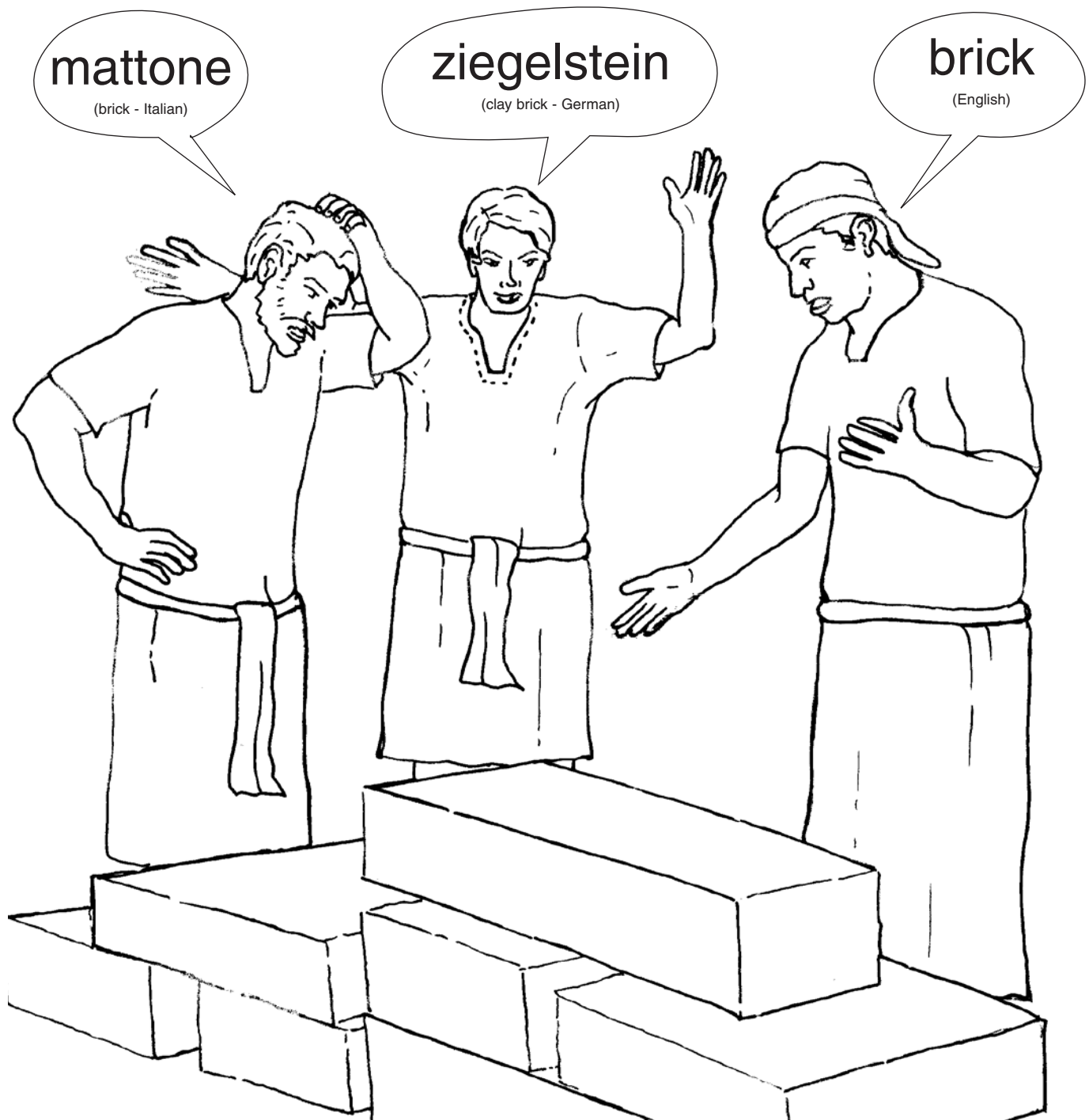

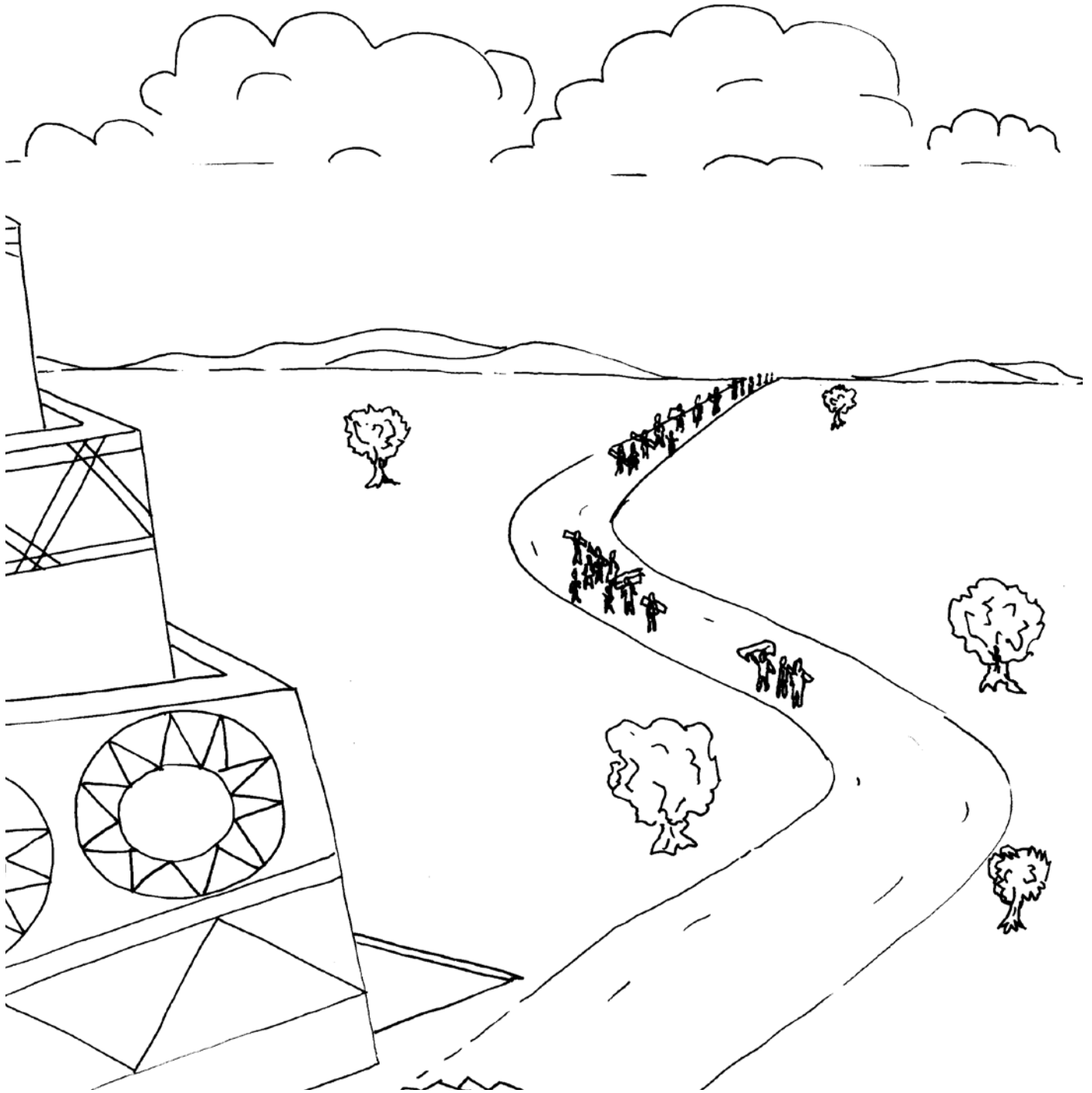
