Purpose and History

The Restored Church of God is an international organization with congregations in more than 70 countries across six continents. With its World Headquarters in Wadsworth, Ohio, the Church teaches God's revealed way of life (Matthew 28:19-20) and preaches the good news (the gospel) of the soon-coming Kingdom of God (Mark

The Restored Church of God is independent and not affiliated with other religious organizations. It does not publicly appeal for funds or actively seek new members. Believing that only God Himself can spiritually attract members (John 6:44), the Church is non-proselytizing and non-political. All of its publications and programs are offered free of charge in the public

Established in 1999 by Pastor General David C. Pack, The Restored Church of God traces its history back through the Worldwide Church of God, led by Herbert W. Armstrong, to the original first-century Church established in AD 31 by Jesus Christ.

Following the teachings of Jesus Christ, the Founder of the Church, members strive to live by every word of God (Matthew 4:4), as revealed in both the Old and New Testaments. As did Jesus and the first-century Church, members of The Restored Church of God keep the seventh-day Sabbath (Friday sundown to Saturday sundown) and the annual Holy Days, including Passover, the Days of Unleavened Bread, and the Feast of Tabernacles (Mark 2:27-28; Leviticus 23; John 7:8, 14; I Corinthians

The original Church was led by a tiny group that eventually had a profound effect on the world of their time. While also having started small, The Restored Church of God is experiencing steady growth and increasing impact around the world. Through its materials, people are learning sound principles to help them lead productive lives and become better examples and better citizens—in their local communities.

Wealth of Knowledge Through Free Materials

The Restored Church of God, which hosts the largest biblically based website on Earth, provides an ever-expanding array of published books, booklets and articles—all without cost or obligation—to guide those seeking to live God's Way. The material, available in multiple languages (including English, Spanish, French, German, Dutch, Italian, Afrikaans, Swahili, Polish, Serbian and Tahitian), brings plain understanding of the insoluble problems overwhelming mankind, and points to the lasting peace of the world to come, just over the horizon.

AC seeks to achieve excellence in teaching while providing an educational setting that will serve to further character and personality development.













The purpose of Ambassador Center is twofold:

Fact Sheet about the Feast of Tabernacles

Following the biblical teachings of Jesus Christ, members of The Restored Church of God® annually celebrate the Feast of Tabernacles, often simply referred to as "the Feast."

Each year, Church members travel to various cities and observe the Feast season during eight days.

Over the years, members have enjoyed the Feast in various cities around the world such as Taha'a, French
Polynesia; Homa Bay, Kenya; Chennai, India; Residencial La Angostura, Peru; and Bournemouth, England. In the United States, locations include Salt Lake City, Utah; Rogers, Arkansas; Safety Harbor, Florida; and Wadsworth, Ohio.

Evidence of Christians keeping this yearly festival can be traced to the first-century New Testament Church started in AD 31. Jesus kept the Feast, as did the original apostles (John 7:1-11; Acts 18:21).

This yearly festival has its roots in Old Testament teachings. Many of God's servants, including Moses and Samuel, observed it.

The Feast of Tabernacles symbolizes a prophesied time when all of mankind will learn to become more like God, and lead lives of peace and abundance. Church members save a portion of their annual income and use it during the eight days at their site. Family and social activities are scheduled throughout the Feast so members from around the world can become better acquainted with one another. Many visit local tourist attractions with family and friends, and enjoy fine dining establishments available in the area.

Feast attendees go to daily Church services where ministers explain biblical passages about this coming time, teach how to improve interpersonal relationships and marriages, and expound on other Christian-living topics.

Pastor General David C. Pack addresses Church members with unique messages for the occasion and also personally travels to American sites.


The Feast season begins and ends with a day of special meetings and worship. On those occasions, both a morning and afternoon service is conducted, in which the significance of these Holy Days, as found throughout the Bible, is reviewed and explained to Church members.

DAVID C. PACK PRESIDENT AND PASTOR GENERAL THE RESTORED CHURCH OF GOD®

As Pastor General of The Restored Church of God, David C. Pack oversees the world's most extensive biblically based websites. He attended Ambassador College and entered the Worldwide Church of God ministry in 1971. He has established more than 63 congregations, authored over 80 books and booklets, written hundreds of articles, and appeared on *The History Channel*. As Publisher and Editor-in-Chief of *The Real Truth* magazine and voice of the program *The World*



to Come, he has reached many millions around the globe with the most powerful truths of the Bible, unknown to almost all.

Born in 1948, Mr. Pack grew up in the American Midwest, in Lima, Ohio. Focused largely on sports and competitive swimming for 14 years, and having achieved high school all-American honors, as well as having begun training for the 1968 Olympics, Mr. Pack experienced a major turning point that became a course-altering—and Life-altering—event. He began to listen to *The World Tomorrow* radio program, sponsored by the Radio Church of God (later renamed the Worldwide Church of God), and heard Herbert W. Armstrong announce the true gospel of the Bible—the good news of the coming Kingdom of God.

Declining acceptance to Dartmouth College, as well as an appointment to the United States Naval Academy, and numerous scholarship offers, Mr. Pack chose to attend Ambassador College in Pasadena, California, world headquarters of the Church. Upon graduation in 1971, he married Shirley Ochs (who died in 2007), a fellow Ambassador College graduate and former personal secretary to Mr. Armstrong, and entered the ministry. He served congregations in Indiana, Illinois, Wisconsin, New York, New Jersey, and Ohio, and trained and supervised other ministers in a wider region.

Having begun as a writer in the late 1970s, Mr. Pack's vast array of books, booklets and articles has helped millions learn biblical truths as never before. He has traveled the world, pastored thousands, and conducted many public Bible lectures. Mr. Pack has also held a number of leadership positions that have given him a wide range of ministerial and administrative experience.

Upon Mr. Armstrong's death in January 1986, the true gospel message and virtually every teaching that flows from this most central truth was rejected by his successors. Standing on conviction, Mr. Pack left the Worldwide Church of God in 1993, educating and leading the way for thousands who would follow.

Determined not to compromise his beliefs, Mr. Pack started The Restored Church of God in May 1999. The organization is truly unique, unlike any other on Earth. Under his leadership, it proclaims a powerful and positive message, answering the greatest question on the minds of billions: What is the purpose of human existence? This requires special focus on the scriptural solutions to the awful problems, troubles, evils and ills mankind has always faced, but which have grown much worse in the 21st century.

Mr. Pack's and the Church's materials address the everyday concerns of the average man and woman—and do so without soliciting funds, proselytizing or involvement in politics. All literature and programs are offered free of charge and in the public interest. Mr. Pack is dedicated to teaching the only path to world peace—the good news beyond today's bad news. In this regard, he has produced or guided into production a vast reservoir of educational material for people of every age.
