Ambassador Center's first annual graduation ceremony was held at the beautiful Stan Hywet Hall and Gardens in Akron, Ohio.



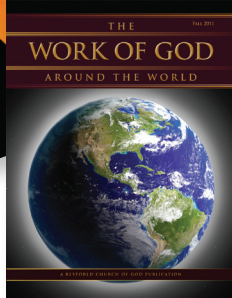
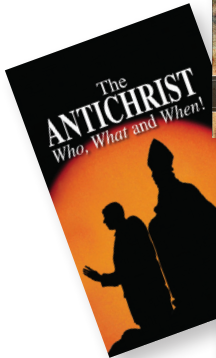
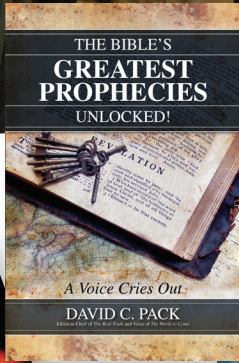
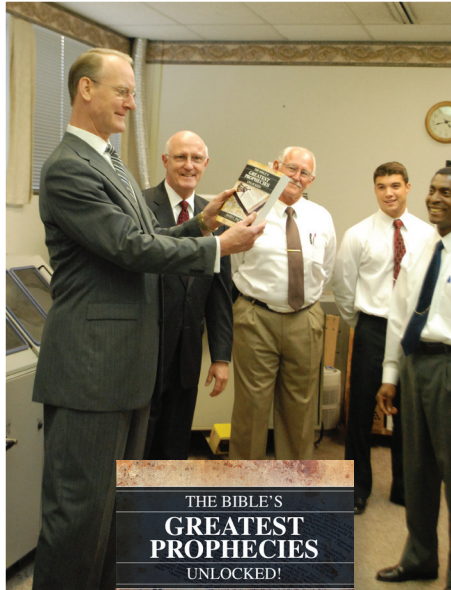
Mr. Pack confers diplomas to students of the 2011 graduating class. The ceremony was held at the magnificent Canton Club Event Center in Canton, Ohio.



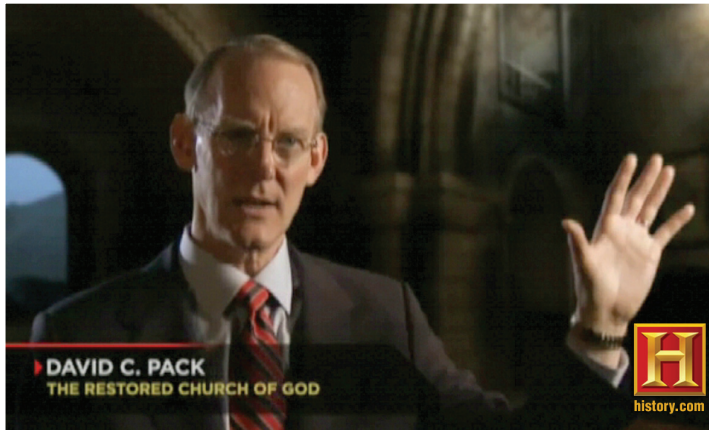
Restored Church of God ministers and leaders attended the 2010 Ministerial Conference. A wide range of subjects were addressed to help the ministry in properly feeding God's flock.
